MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR

TO : ALL PROVINCIAL GOVERNOR, CITY/MUNICIPALITY MAYORS, DILG REGIONAL DIRECTORS, PROVINCIAL DIRECTORS AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT OPERATIONS OFFICERS

SUBJECT : CULTURE-BASED GOVERNANCE TRAINING: SEMINAR WORKSHOP ON THE DOCUMENTATION OF INTANGIBLE CULTURAL HERITAGE

The Philippine Cultural Education Program (PCEP) of the National Commission for Culture and the Arts (NCCA) in partnership with the Department of the Interior and Local Government will hold the **CULTURE-BASED GOVERNANCE TRAINING: Seminar Workshop on the Documentation of Intangible Cultural Heritage**. The activity has the following objectives:

1. To provide a venue for a review of LGU practices on governance that is culture-based within their respective localities;
2. To provide opportunities for young leaders to develop a culture-based leadership and skills;
3. To coordinate efforts and mechanisms for resource and expertise sharing on cultural education programming;
4. To share experiences and approaches in managing heritage sites, cultural events, artist development and cultural education; and
5. To engage participants in developing and formulating modules on LGUs' cultural education plan and crafting of local ordinance (as upheld by Republic Act No. 10066 National Cultural Heritage Act of 2009 and Republic Act No. 7160 – Local Government Code) to institutionalize culture and arts programs by creating culture and arts office with annual budget allocations.

The said national training is designed for all local government staff, tourism officers, cultural officers, teachers, artist and cultural workers.

In this regard, all Provincial, City and Municipal Local Chief Executives are hereby encouraged to participate to the training. Interested parties may pre-register online at <http://ncca.gov.ph/philippine-cultural-education-program-pcep/philippine-cultural-education-pcep-online-form/>. Registration is first come first serve basis. The online registration will automatically close when it reaches the required maximum number of participants.

All participants from Luzon are encouraged to join the Luzon Cluster in Bataan on June 7-9, 2018 while the Visayas and Mindanao participants should join the Visayas Cluster in Roxas City on June 14-16, 2018.

Said training is free of any registration fees. All participants will be provided with workshop kits, materials and certificate of participation. NCAA will provide lunch during the training. Roundtrip transportation to and from venue, other meals and accommodations may be authorized, chargeable against local funds, subject to the availability of funds and existing accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
