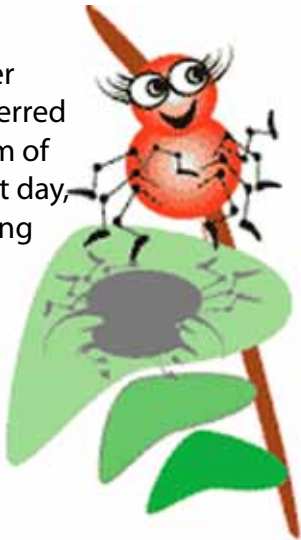


DIEGO THE SPIDER
