SUBJECT: PETITION TO DECLARE AS AN IMPORTANT CULTURAL PROPERTY, THE IMACULATE HEART OF MARY PARISH (IHMP), U.P. VILLAGE, DILIMAN, QUEZON CITY.

In compliance with the publication requirement pursuant to Section 8 of R.A. 10066 and Section 11 of the Implementing Rules and Regulations of R.A. 10066. Notice is hereby served to the public that Fr. Antonio Eucapor, parish priest of Immaculate Heart of Mary Parish (IHMP), U.P. Village, Diliman, Quezon City, has filed a petition to declare the IHMP Parish Church as an Important Cultural Property (ICP).

Based on the arguments of the petitioner, the Parish Church was constructed in 1969 and its original design was made by National Artist for Architecture, Leandro V. Locsin. Thus, the structure being at least 50 years old and being allegedly designed by a National Artist, R.A. 10066 classifies such property as a Presumed Important Cultural Property¹. Hence, the Commission took cognizance of said petition.

Any person who wish to support or those who are adversely affected by aforesaid petition may file his/her written opposition not later than 30 January 2019².
